

Shana's Table , Episode 4

We've been working on other things in the shop but today Shana and Libba get back to the table. With all the joinery complete, "buttons" are made which will be used to fasten the top to the aprons. Countersunk screw holes are drilled using a simple fixture to hold them in place.



Shana uses a No. 4 smooth plane to even the glue joints in some spots and then all parts are sanded.





Using a random orbit sander, Shana sands the table top while Libba finishes up the legs and aprons. The next day they apply the first coat of oil finish to all parts. The table has not been assembled yet so as to not take up shop space.
