

## Bluebird House

These are photos of the Bluebird House we will provide as “kits” at the Swamp Life Expo on Oct. 3. A plan is also attached. We are asking each club member to cut out the parts for a few birdhouses. As people come by our booth, kids will be given the opportunity and guidance (by us) to build their own birdhouse and bring it home. So we need plenty “kits” a few hammers and 4d finish nails. If 30 of us each make 3, that’s 90 houses. If 20 of us each make 5, that’s 100 houses. If 15 of us each make 4, that’s 60 houses. I prefer the 30/3 ratio simply because it involves more club members. For that matter, if all 58 of us each made 2.....



Front and side views. Note the screw bottom center of the front. That screw holds the front on and allows removal for cleaning. (no hinges required)



The birdhouses can be made of cypress, white pine, cedar or any softwood that nails easily. We all need to stick to the plan as closely as possible so that all kits will be the same. Just cut out the parts, predrill the holes and bundle ‘em up.

You know all those scraps piled up in the corner.... this is a good way to justify having kept them all those years. This will be a great thing for a lot of kids and think about all those homeless Bluebirds we’ll be helping.
