Building and Installing an Art Deco Style Bathroom Vanity





Libba cuts dados at the table saw and cuts parts to length at the radial arm saw.





Using glue, nail gun and clamps, the cabinet is assembled. Wood edge tape is applied to all drawer parts and the the drawers are assembled.





The cabinet completed, Shana now cuts out a portion of the top to receive the sink. Libba and Shana then attach drawer guides and begin fastening the false fronts.



Libba finished the vanity with shellac and paint and it is now ready to be installed. She now cuts holes through the cabinet back for plumbing and appliances and then attaches it to the wall.







Now the doors and drawers are reinstalled and here is the finished vanity complete with granite top.
