After contacting her, we decided on a box with 2 layers, a top that opens and a drawer that would hold 16-20 watches. She said she liked cypress and I had some old cypress around the shop that was large enough pieces to make the box. I wanted to do dovetails so I made the corners dovetails. I then cut the front of the drawer off the bottom of the box to preserve the dovetails all the way down when it was closed and eventually reattached that to the drawer. I used barrel hinges to connect the top. The knobs I found in the 'junk drawer' at the Honeymoon Bungalow on Government.
