Safety Minute - Table Saw Kickback - Mark Monistere

Talked about how fast kickbacks happen, how it is hard to determine what went wrong because of the speed involved. The tip of the blade can be traveling around 120 mph. Riving knifes helps eliminate some kick backs. A splitter installed behind the blade also helps. Don't use miter gauge and saw fence at the same time. Can cause a piece of wood to be come trapped and cause the blade to sling the wood. Never push a board through the saw so that the right side of the board contacts the back edge of the blade. Will cause saw to lift the board and sling it to the back.
