Hearing loss is a gradual thing, no immediate symptoms, effect is over time. Hearing protection should be used with every loud or consistent noisy activity. ISOtunes is one type of hearing protection that include bluetooth technology thus allowing the wearer to listen to music, podcast or other types of audio while providing a 27db reduction in ambient noise.
